CATEGORY NO.1: SCIENTIFIC OFFICER/C (MEDICAL)

Pay Band - ₹. 15600 – 39100/- & Grade Pay - ₹. 5400/- (PB-3)

Total Emoluments : (i.e., Initial pay in the Pay Band + Grade Pay + DA + NPA + HRA & Transport Allowance as per A-1 Class City + DA on transport allowance) = **₹.54,406/- p.m.(approx.)**

Essential Qualification & field of experience : M.B.B.S. degree from a recognized University with at least 1(one) year institutional experience in the relevant field after obtaining the degree. Degree should be recognized by the Medical Council of India. Mandatory internship shall not be counted as experience.

Candidates with Post Graduate qualification and equivalent need not apply.

Maximum Age Limit : Not more than 35 years as on 17.02.2012.

Note: Selected candidate may preferably reside in the departmental accommodation located near VECC office campus i.e. at Anushakti Abasan, Salt Lake.

RELAXATION IN UPPER AGE LIMIT

(1) RELAXATION IN THE UPPER AGE LIMIT OF 5 YEARS SHALL BE ADMISSIBLE TO ALL PERSONS WHO HAD ORDINARILY BEEN DOMICILED IN KASHMIR DIVISION, THE STATE OF JAMMU & KASHMIR DURING THE PERIOD FROM THE 1ST DAY OF JANUARY 1980 TO 31ST DAY OF DECEMBER, 1989 PROVIDED THAT THE RELAXATION IN THE UPPER AGE LIMIT FOR APPEARING AT ANY EXAMINATION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF CHANCES PERMISSIBLE UNDER THE RELEVANT RULES.

CERTIFICATE REGARDING PROOF OF RESIDENCE - ANY PERSON INTENDING TO AVAIL OF THIS RELAXATION OF AGE LIMIT ADMISSIBLE UNDER RULE 3 SHALL SUBMIT A CERTIFICATE FROM: (a) THE DIST. MAGISTRATE IN THE KASHMIR DIVISION WITHIN WHOSE JURISDICTION HE HAD ORDINARILY RESIDED; OR (b) ANY OTHER AUTHORITY DESIGNATED IN THIS BEHALF BY THE GOVERNMENT OF JAMMU & KASHMIR TO THE EFFECT THAT HE HAD ORDINARILY BEEN DOMICILED IN THE KASHMIR DIVISION OF THE STATE OF JAMMU & KASHMIR DURING THE PERIOD FROM THE 1ST DAY OF JANUARY, 1980 TO THE 31ST DAY OF DECEMBER, 1989.

HOW TO APPLY :

1. Application should be submitted in the proforma given herewith.
2. Application should preferably be type written on A4 size paper.
3. The Application and the outer cover should be superscribed as "Application for the post of _____ Category No. _____ against Advertisement No.VECC-1/2012".
4. PHOTOGRAPH: A recent passport size photograph should be affixed on the right hand top corner of the application duly signed by the candidate across the photograph. **One extra photograph without signature should also be enclosed.**
5. Only one application should be submitted for one post. If a candidate wishes to apply for more than one post, separate application should be submitted for each post.
6. Application should accompany copies of following certificates (relevant only) duly attested by a Gazetted Officer:
 - (a) Educational and Technical qualifications and all marks sheets for all the years of study of the qualifying examination.
 - (b) Date of Birth proof (SSC Certificate / Birth Certificate issued by Registrar of Births and Deaths).
 - (c) Certificates issued by the Competent Authorities in support of their claim as SC/ST/OBC/Physically Challenged. Candidates belonging to OBC should furnish the caste certificate (Not BC) in the prescribed format.

- (d) Non-creamy layer certificate in the case of OBC candidate as per DoPT O.M. No. 36033/3/2004-Estt. (Res.) dated 14.10.2008.
- (e) Experience Certificate, wherever required, specially stating the nature of work done. No. of years of relevant experience should be after obtaining the requisite qualification.
- (f) Certificate regarding domiciled in Kashmir division from 01.01.1980 to 31.12.1989 (if claiming age relaxation for Kashmir division).

IMPORTANT REQUIREMENT OF PH CERTIFICATE

- i) According to the Persons With Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Rules, 1996 notified on 31/12/1996 by the Central Government in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) and (2) of Section 73 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 (1 of 1996), a disability certificate shall be issued by a Medical Board duly constituted by the Central or a State Government. The Central/State Government may constitute a Medical Board consisting of at least three members, out of which, at least, one member shall be a Specialist from the relevant field.
- ii) The certificate would be valid for a period of 5 years for those whose disability is temporary. The Medical Board shall indicate the period of validity of the certificate where there are chances of variation in the degree of disability. For those who acquired permanent disability, the validity can be shown as Permanent. On representation by the applicant, the Medical Board may review its decision having regard to all the facts and circumstances of the case and pass such orders in the matter as it thinks fit.
- iii) Those SC/ST/OBC persons with disabilities selected on their own merit without relaxed standards alongwith other candidates, will be considered against unreserved vacancies provided the post is identified for persons with disability of relevant category.

General Conditions:

- a) The vacancies shown above are provisional and subject to variation. The filling up of vacancies indicated in the advertisement is also subject to the approval of Competent Authority and may not be filled up if decided otherwise in terms of the orders issued from Government from time to time. VECC reserves the right to fill up all the posts or alter the number of posts or even cancel the whole process of recruitment and change the Centre of examination without any notice.
- b) Candidates possessing qualifications higher than prescribed, which makes them eligible for appointment to higher grade / post, may not be considered on the grounds of over qualification and hence need not apply.

- c) Trade Test/Interviews of the candidates will be held in the office premises of this Centre. The candidates belonging to only SC/ST called for Trade Test/interview from outstation and those who are not employed in Central / State Government / Public Sector Undertaking / Corporation / Local Government / Panchayats etc. are eligible for reimbursement of II Class/Sleeper Class Rail fare or Bus fare to the place of interview and back by the shortest route as admissible under the rules subject to production of Ticket / Tickets and un-employment Certificate from MLA/MP/ Gazetted Officer. If concessional tickets are available reimbursement will be limited to the concessional fare only.
- d) Candidate selected for the post of Category No.2 will be posted at Regional Radiation Medicine Centre, Thakurpukur, Kolkata (an unit of VECC, Kolkata) and is liable to serve in any part of India and in any constituent unit of the Department of Atomic Energy. Candidates selected for the other categories of posts are likely to be posted at VECC, Kolkata but are liable to serve in any part of India and in any constituent unit of the Department of Atomic Energy.
- e) The nature of duties to be performed by the above categories of employees will involve working in round-the-clock shift duties (including night shift), in operational plants and areas.
- f) Persons who are appointed against the above posts, will be covered under the New Contributory Pension Scheme as notified by the Government of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure vide Notification No. F.No.5/7/2003-ECB & PR dated 22.12.2003.
- g) Persons working under the Central/State Govt./Public Sector Undertakings should submit their applications through proper channel. They may, however, send an advance copy of the application along with enclosures as detailed above to the address given below, which should reach before the prescribed last date.
