

## Report on VECC Swachhata Action Plan (SAP) for the period from October to December, 2022

In tune with the year-long Swachhata activities and as a part of Swachha Bharat Mission of Government of India, Swachhata Committee VECC has taken a leading role in execution of a series of activities during the last few years in cleanliness, beautification and tree plantation programme of our VECC Bidhannagar campus, Rajarhat campus, Chakgaria campus and Anusahakti Abasan Bidhannagar. The Committee also took initiatives and worked on imposing and maintaining the Covid-19 restrictions / guidelines, sanitization etc. and organized several public awareness programme as per government orders. The following Swachhata related works have been carried out during October - December, 2022.

### CLEANLINESS AND BEAUTIFICATION CAMPAIGN:

VECC Swachhata Committee was instrumental in organizing the cleanliness and beautification campaign of all the three campuses at regular intervals. Segregation of waste of almost 14000 CFT accumulated in the scrap yard and disposal of non sellable waste of approximately 8500 CFT from all over the VECC Bidhannagar Campus was carried out during the said period.
